Jesus' Story of the Soils: Luke 8:4-15

Farmer = God Seed = God's Word Soil = My Life

1. I MUST BE R T G.

"A farmer went out to plant some seed. As he scattered it across his field, some seed fell on a footpath, where it was stepped on, and the birds came and ate it." Luke 8:5 (NLT)

"The hard path where some seed fell represents the hard hearts of those who hear the words of God, but then the devil comes and steals the words away and prevents people from believing and being saved." Luke 8:12 (LB)

The hardened path = A C M (3 Causes)

The shallow soil = S C.
